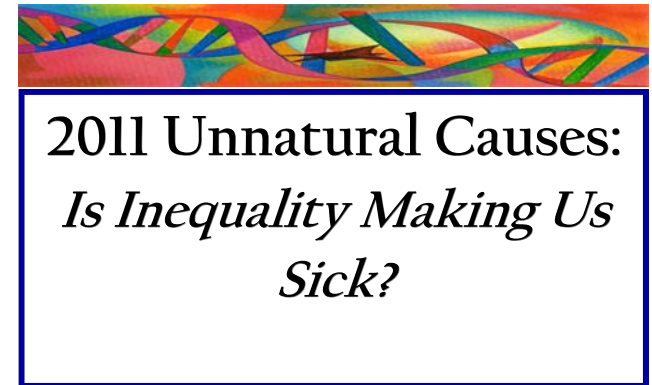

Focus

- ✓ To determine the best ways to address the gaps among populations and specific diseases
- ✓ To identify possible solutions, methods, and programs that will address the gaps and improve the effectiveness of existing programs, and more efficiently apply resources; and
- ✓ To build a renewed sense of teamwork across communities, and to help in the work of establishing coalitions
